It provides all types of nutritious and hygienic eatables and beverages to cater to needs of the students, staff and visitors. The canteen has been functioning efficiently in our college. The Management of the canteen is directly under the control of the college administration. The contractor of the canteen is selected according to the available and suitable quotations. Students and staff of the college are benefited by the college canteen. The contract of the canteen is renewed every year. The canteen committee members frequently visit the canteen to check food quality as well as sanitary conditions.

INFRASTRUCTURE:

Canteen facility is made available to the students & staff members to cater to the needs of refreshment. The canteen was newly constructed in the year 2020 to meet the refreshment requirements of the students & other staff members of the college. It is located on the ground floor on the back side of the college building, just adjacent to the Gym Khana. The construction was commenced in the month of April 2019 which got completed by December 2019.

Area of Canteen: 1296 Sq. Ft.

The timing of canteen: between 08:00 a.m. and 03:00 p.m.

Equipment and infrastructure: There are sufficient number of tables & chairs in the canteen where the students can sit.

- 6) Canteen service provider will systematic arrangement of tables and chairs.
- 7) Canteen service provider will avoid repetitive use of cooking oil.
- 8) Canteen service provider will take responsibility of electronic gadgets maintenance, tables, chairs and other furniture provided by the management.
- 9) Daily menu of food items should be displayed.
- 10) Canteen service provider will be maintaining the hygiene in the canteen, and it will be solely the responsibility of the proprietor.
- 11) Canteen service provider will take care of wet and dry garbage disposal at their own cost.
- 12) Canteen service provider will make arrangements for unpacked drinking water and water to use in canteen.
- 13. Rent and monthly electricity charges will be paid by canteen service provider on or before ----date of each month.
- 14. Deposit amount will be Rs 35,000/-.
- 15. Monthly rental amount will be Rs 6,000/-.
